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Why Soundfields...


- 30% of average elementary (K-6) students fail a 15dB screening test.
- 75% of children with a mild hearing loss have academic deficiencies by 6th grade
- 97% of classrooms in a 1994 study failed the recommended acoustical standard for good learning environment.



Research has shown

Soundfields:


- Improve reading and language test scores (K-6 students)
- Improve student attention
- Reduce student distractions
- Reduce need to repeat directions
- Improved classroom management
- Students reported that they were better able to understand and pay attention to the teacher

- Amplify complementary devices and information in the classroom
